Main points raised and positions expressed:	<p><i>The Commission recalled the reasons behind its plan to revise the CPC Regulation in the 4th quarter of 2026 as highlighted in its 2030 Consumer Agenda, including the possibility of centralised investigation and enforcement powers at EU level in specific cases, and how to further strengthen coordination among national authorities under the CPC Regulation.</i></p> <p><i>The presentation was followed by an exchange of views with AmCham EU's members on the different elements of the revision and its implication for US companies.</i></p>
