<b>Main points raised and positions expressed:</b>	<i>Eurochambres expressed strong support for the EU Inc. proposal, which it considered to be very positive. Eurochambres expressed particular attention to the implementation phase that would follow the adoption. A consultation with members is currently underway on this legal text. On the Digital Fairness Act, Eurochambres insisted on coherence with other legislations and avoiding another layer of legislation. On Empowering consumers for the green transition, Eurochambres enquired on a grandfathering clause for old stocks.</i>
