Subject matter:	<i>Digital Fairness Act (DFA)</i>
Main points raised and positions expressed:	<i>Paramount expressed their views with respect to the Commission's ongoing work on the Digital Fairness Act. They stressed the need to avoid overly prescriptive rules with regard to subscriptions and free trials, and to ensure simplification and avoid potential abuse regarding the right of withdrawal (RoW) for the audio-visual media services. They underlined that current rules of RoW in the streaming sector could disincentivise long-term subscriptions, as customers opting for discounted annual plans might withdraw early, undermining the pricing model. Paramount also inquired about next steps.</i>
