Dedenting interpolating heredoc can interpret escapes incorrectly

Description It is clear that the dedenting <<~HEREDOC feature was intended to only consider actual whitespace in the source file as indentation, not any escaped whitespace. E.g.: <pre>p <<~"E" \ x y E</pre> It prints "x\n y\n". So "\ " does not count as whitespace. There is even an MRI test for this. However, this case is handled differently: <pre>p <<~"E" x\n y E</pre> It prints "x\n y\n". So "\n" is counted as whitespace, like an actual newline would be. I think it should print "x\n y\n".
