Description					
A segmentation bug occurred when running rspec tests on an app. This first appeared using ruby 2.3.0p0 revision 53290, and appeared similar to bugs reported in issues https://bugs.ruby-lang.org/issues/12000 and https://bugs.ruby-lang.org/issues/12000 and https://bugs.ruby-lang.org/issues/12000 and https://bugs.ruby-lang.org/issues/11928 . 11928 implies that the bug should have been fixed at revision 53524, so I have updated ruby to 2.3.0p7 revision 53608 and am still getting segmentation faults.
