<div>Description</div> <div>=begin</div> <div>Currently if you don't have zlib headers installed and you run the tests, it yields:</div> <div>...</div> <div>C:/dev/ruby/downloads/ruby_trunk/test/rubygems/test_gem_spec_fetcher.rb: no such file to load -- zlib</div> <div>repeat many times</div> <div>...</div> <div>I'd suggest that core fallback on a pure ruby zlib if a C one isn't installed.</div> <div>zliby , http://blade.nagaokaut.ac.jp/cgi-bin/scat.rb/ruby/ruby-talk/324563</div> <div>of course, there's no pure ruby openssl so I'm not sure if this would actually be enough to allow rubygems tests to run, but it would still in general be nice.</div> <div>Thanks!</div> <div>-=r</div> <div>=end</div>
