User must parse it and retrieve filename and linenum by rexp. It is also very heavy weight task. <p>I think many have wished for objectified trace.</p> <p>caller[0].file caller[0].line caller[0].in</p> <p>Different method would be needed than #caller though to prevent backward compatibility issue.</p>
