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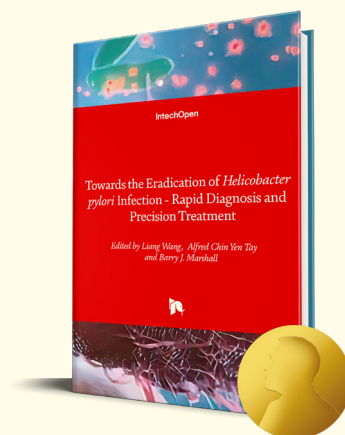


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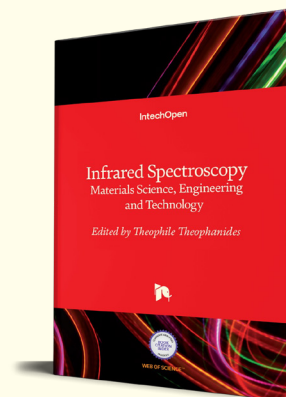

QUALIFICATIONS



As prerequisites for this role, we have established key criteria related to professional experience and interpersonal skills. These include:



PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE/KNOWLEDGE:

1. A PhD degree and/or MD is required, preferably with post-doctoral experience, an equivalent degree with several additional years of academic work or an equivalent to a recognised qualification in the relevant field of research.
2. Demonstrated expertise and research experience in the specific field related to the book scope.
3. A strong publication record, including articles and/or books related to the specialist field. Previous editorial/reviewing experience is desirable.
4. Previous editorial/reviewing experience is desirable.



INTERPERSONAL SKILLS:

1. Excellent critical assessment skills
2. Very good organizational skills
3. Effectively managing deadlines

RESPONSIBILITIES



- **Book Outline:**

Develop a comprehensive outline for the book.

- **Submission Assessment:**

Carefully evaluate all submissions, deciding whether to accept, reject, or provide suggestions for further revision.

- **Review Process:**

Review submissions in adherence with IntechOpen's [Editorial Policies](#) and ensure compliance with COPE Ethical Guidelines for Peer Reviewers.

- **Plagiarism Check:**

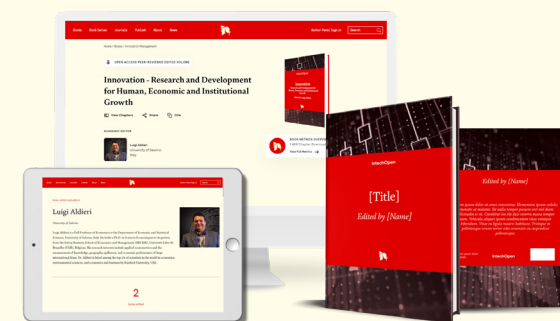
Utilize the provided tool, iThenticate, to perform plagiarism checks.

- **Table of Contents:**

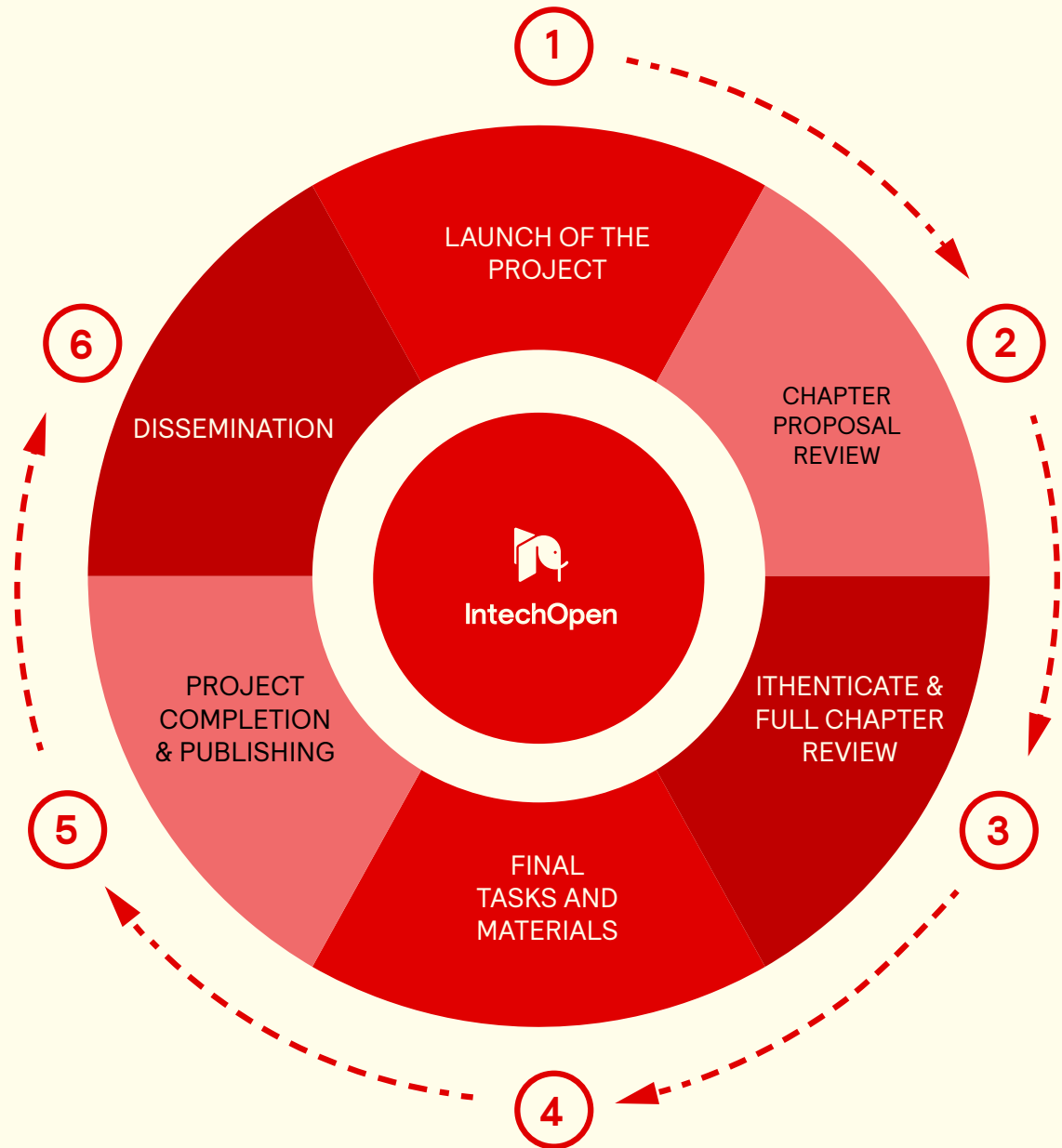
Define the book's table of contents based on manuscripts that successfully passed the review process.

- **Final Title and Preface:**

Define a final title of the book and contribute a preface that introduces the book to the desired audience.



PUBLICATION PROCESS



PUBLICATION PROCESS



1. Registrations of authors and chapter proposal submission

2. Chapter proposal review
Authors of accepted chapter proposals are invited to submit a full chapter.

3. Full chapter review

Options:

- Accept
- Minor review
- Major review
- Reject

After the completion of technical editing and upon payment of the Chapter Processing Charge (CPC), accepted chapters are published individually as ‘**Online First**’ before the finalisation of the whole book.

4. Final tasks and materials:

- book’s structure and table of contents
- preface, back cover text, updated CV

5. The project is released online several weeks after the editor delivers the final materials.

6. The published book is evaluated, screened for compliance with particular database requirements, and submitted for evaluation to relevant abstracting and indexing services, including:

- **Web of Science - Book Citation Index (only selected titles)**
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- **Google Scholar**
- **Doab**
- **Semantic Scholar**
- **Open AIRE and others**
