

ECOSOC Decision 2002/206

First session of the Committee of Experts on Public Administration and its provisional agenda

At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 13 February 2002, the Economic and Social Council approved the holding of the first session of the Committee of Experts on Public Administration in New York from 22 to 26 July 2002, as well as the provisional agenda and documentation set out below.

Provisional agenda and documentation for the first session of the Committee of Experts on Public Administration

1. Election of officers.
2. Adoption of the agenda and other organizational matters.
3. Enhancing the capacity of public administration to implement the United Nations Millennium Declaration.

4. Basic data on the public sector.

5. Review of United Nations activities on public administration.

Paper to be submitted by the Secretariat on the general trends of United Nations activities in public administration for the review and guidance of the Committee

6. Proposed programme of work and agenda for the next meeting.
