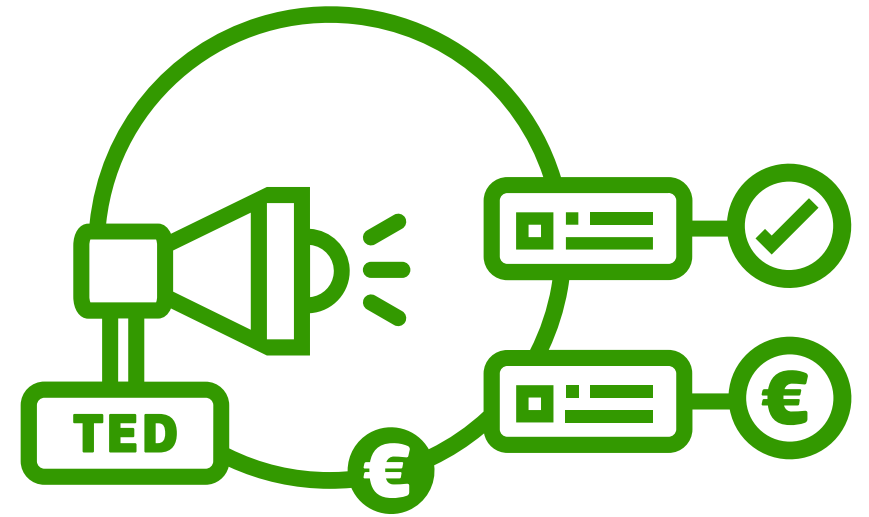

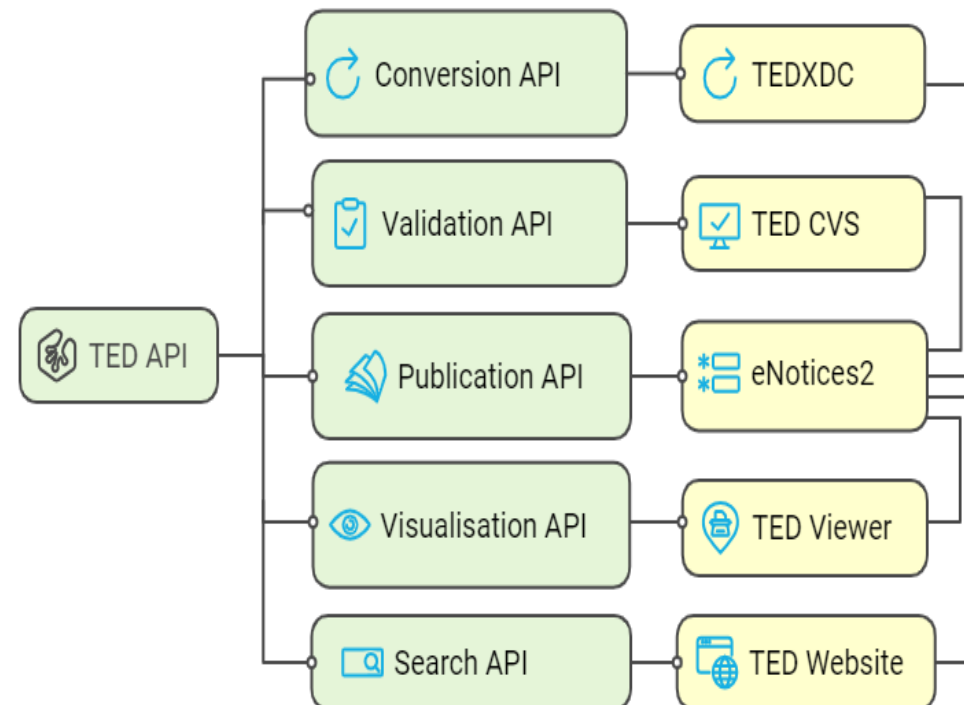


TED API – A single domain api.ted.europa.eu

- Use a single domain api.ted.europa.eu to:
 - Convert XML notice from the old TED XML format to a partial eForms notice.
 - Validate notices before submission for publication.
 - Submit notices for publication.
 - Visualise notices before submission for publication.
 - Search and retrieve published procurement notices from the TED website (TED Search API)

TED search API – 2 URLs for the same endpoint

- As the access to TED API is in a single domain `api.ted.europa.eu`, TED Search API can be accessed via the 2 following URLs:
 - Primary URL: <https://api.ted.europa.eu/v3/notices/search>
 - Secondary URL: <https://tedweb.api.ted.europa.eu/v3/notices/search>

The secondary URL is already available in case the primary URL is not available

TED search API – Search fields

- There are **about 1250 search fields**
- Search fields have aliases: you can find the same information using the alias of the search field.
 - For example, if you want to find notices published on 20 November 2024, you can use any of the queries listed below to get the same results:
 - publication-date=20241120
 - BT-05(a)-notice=20241120
 - PD=20241120
