1 CHAIR'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

Update on BUDG requests for rule 57 on the European Semester for economic policy coordination 2026 (ECON) and on Gender Mainstreaming in the EP (FEMM)

The Chair informed the coordinators about the state of play of the BUDG requests for rule 57 on the European Semester for economic policy coordination 2026 (ECON) and on Gender Mainstreaming in the EP (FEMM). Following rejection by ECON coordinators of the BUDG request to draw up an opinion, the BUDG Chair will write a letter to the CCC Chair and ECON Chair reiterating the BUDG position.

Update on BUDG requests for Rule 59 on the NRPP, the ECF and Global Europe

The Chair informed the coordinators about the state of play of the BUDG requests for rule 59 on the NRPP, the ECF and Global Europe. Coordinators reiterated the fact that BUDG should be involved in the three files given its horizontal role.

2.2 Performance framework Regulation – request from other committees

Coordinators agreed to accept requests for Rule 57 opinion (DEVE, ECON, TRAN and PECH) and reject requests for Rule 59 (joint lead) (ITRE, REGI and FEMM), and to propose Rule 57 opinion instead, including to AGRI.

Coordinators mandated the Chair to send a letter to the CCC Chair and the relevant committees, co-signed with the CONT Chair.

2.3 Public hearings in 2026

Coordinators agreed on the following public hearings to be organised in the first half of 2026:

- Support and Long-Term Resilience of EU Agricultural and regional funding, especially in the context of demographic change to be organised jointly with AGRI and REGI (tbc)
- Financing Ukraine's reconstruction through the MFF: how, and from which resources?
- Exploring additional solutions for Own Resources in the EU Budget, for which the exact scope will be decided by the two Own Resources co-rapporteurs.

The exact title and list of speakers for joint hearing(s) will be decided by joint written procedures with the committees concerned (tbc).

2.4 Missions in 2026

As a general rule, BUDG missions are organised during the first part of each year (February until July included).

Coordinators agreed on the following missions to be organised in the first half of 2026:

- United Kingdom
- Ukraine with very limited number of staff, combined or not with Poland.

Following the meeting, coordinators agreed by written procedure not to combine the Ukraine mission with Poland and to organise the mission to the U.K., to Poland and to Ukraine.

Coordinators agreed to ask for a derogation for joint BUDG-ECON RRF missions to be counted outside quota. If the derogation is granted, the repartition will be as follows: 7 quotas for the U.K., 7 quotas for Ukraine and 8 quotas for Poland. If the derogation is not granted, the repartition will be: 4 quotas for the U.K., 4 quotas for Poland and 5 quotas for Ukraine. The Chair will be counted outside quota.

2.5 Appointment of BUDG members to the Joint Consultation Meetings on CFSP

Coordinators agreed to appoint the following BUDG members for the Joint Consultation Meetings on CFSP:

- The Chair of the BUDG Committee (or in his absence, a Vice-Chair);
- The rapporteur (Section III) for the current budgetary year;
- The rapporteur (Section III) for the next budgetary year;
- MFF co-rapporteurs in an alternating order.
