



Zuzana Petková

Slovak journalist, a director of Stop Corruption Foundation – NGO, which main goals are supporting investigative journalism and spreading awareness about transparency. She is founder of Investigative Centre of Jan Kuciak and member of board of this organization.

In her work she has been focused on investigation and reporting about economic crimes. After her articles the famous developer, who had connection with government party, was sentenced. She worked with Jan Kuciak, Slovak murdered journalist. They revealed together several tax frauds, which was committed by controversial entrepreneur Marián Kočner. Now, Kočner is accused from Kuciaks murder. Petková was also monitored and blamed by his criminal group, case is at court.

She is a winner of several prizes. In 2019 she received American award Woman of courage on the national level, in 2018 award White crow – appreciation of socially beneficial civic action. She won national Open Society Journalism award in 2020, 2016, 2013, 2010 and 2009. Her articles are published in daily SME, she is editor of investigative TV program and podcast.

She graduated at Comenius University (journalism) and she is absolvant of program for developing democracy at University for Further Education of Journalist, Kalmar, Sweden.
