

Common term: Urban centre; **Plural:** Urban centres; **Technical term:** High density cluster

Short definition: a cluster of [contiguous grid cells](#) of 1 km² (excluding diagonals) with a population density of at least 1 500 inhabitants per km² and collectively a minimum population of 50 000 inhabitants after gap-filling.
