11. Item non-response categories like "Refused", "Doesn't understand the question", "Don't know", "Not applicable" (in non-bold, black font, italic) were not read out or shown in the show card by the interviewer unless otherwise stated.

[COUNTRY] is a programming instruction. The CAPI device will automatically display the country where the respondent has declared to live for the interviewer to read out.

Same holds true for the programming instruction [ROMA BACKGROUND]: ROMA BACKGROUND is used as an umbrella term and is tailored to the specific term(s) used in the survey countries.

Some of the questions for interviewers are checks (e.g. for plausibility, survey participation requirements). These "checks" will be formatted in the same way as normal questions.

There are questions, where the interviewer is asked to show a card to the respondent (**SHOW CARD XXXX**). Show cards are visual aids from which the respondent chooses the answer to the survey question (see Annex III).
