(Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine).

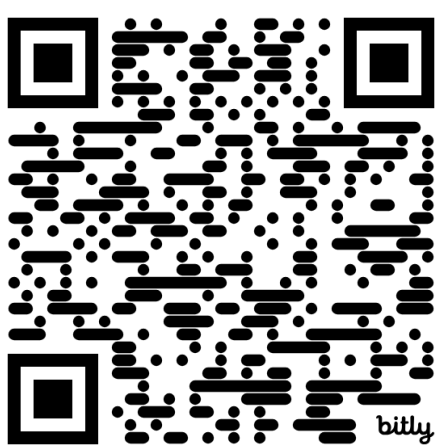
How does it work?

Come up with a project idea and involve partners from at least 3 Visegrad countries, and 1 from the WB or EaP regions, or from at least 2 Visegrad countries, and 2 from the WB or EaP regions.

Register in the MyVisegrad portal and apply in the open calls from/to Jan 1-Feb1 or May1-June1 or Sep1-Oct1



Visegrad+ Grants Scheme



Who can apply?

Any legal entity from any country can apply for support if they fulfil the partnership criteria.

Conditions

- Projects implemented in the WB or EaP regions, and/or having a strong impact on local communities
- Maximum duration of a project is 18 months
- Cover up to 100% of a project budget with maximum 15% of overheads
- Address one of the objectives in the seven grants focus areas
- Consultations no later than 14 days before the application deadline

Visegrad Scholarship Program

Supports Master and post-Master students and researchers in all disciplines and in any language for up to two semesters at educational institutions in the V4.

Support of €3,000/semester for scholar + €1,500/semester for the host institution.

Deadline: April 15

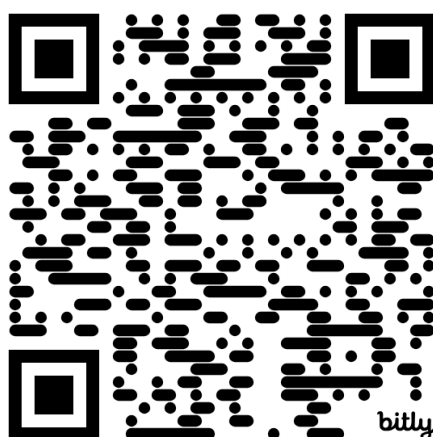
Visegrad Mobility Programs

Western Balkans Visegrad Fellowship Program

Supports lecturers, researchers & scientists in two directions: citizens of V4 can apply to relevant institutions in the WB6 countries, and citizens of the WB6 can apply to relevant institutions in V4 countries.

Support of €500/week plus travel grant

Visegrad Scholarship at the Open Society Archives

Supports scholars, artists or journalists who wish to conduct research at OSA, and whose current research projects are relevant to the research priorities.

Support of €3,000 /two months

**Deadlines:
July 25 and November 15**

Research Grants at Historical Archives of the EU

Supports scholars interested in European integration with a unique research experience in the HAEU in Florence.

Support of €5,000
