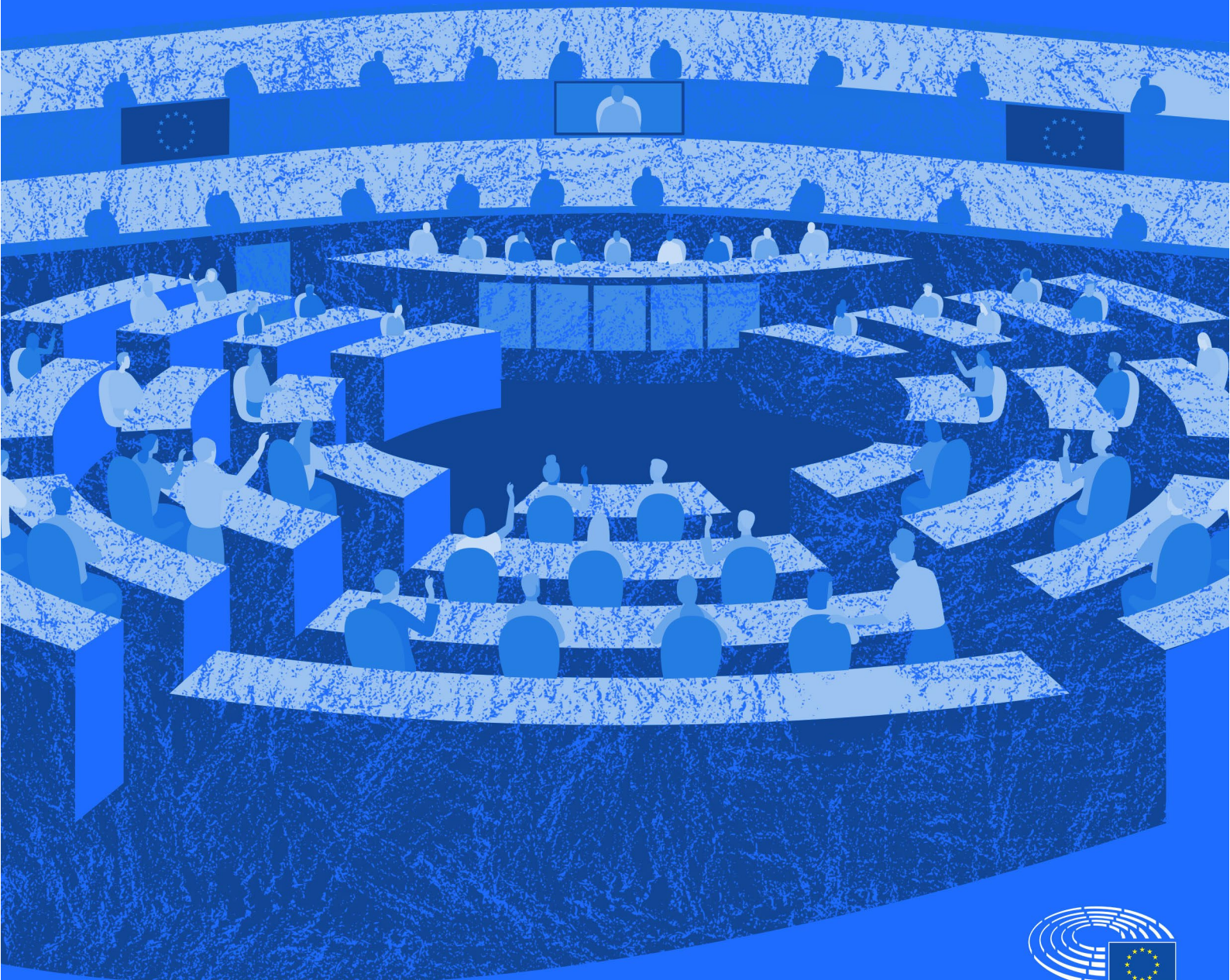

# Activity Report 2019–2024

## COMMITTEE ON FOREIGN AFFAIRS (AFET)

### HIGHLIGHTS OF THE 9th LEGISLATURE

The European Parliament's Committee on Foreign Affairs (AFET) is responsible for the promotion, implementation and monitoring of the Union's common foreign and security policy. The Committee also provides political oversight and coordinates the work of joint parliamentary committees and parliamentary cooperation committees, as well as that of the inter-parliamentary delegations and ad hoc delegations falling within its remit.

During the 9th legislature, under the chairmanship of David McAllister, AFET, together with its Subcommittees on Human Rights (DROI) and Security and Defence (SEDE), made a significant contribution to the definition of the EU's foreign and security policy.

In many ways, the 2019–2024 mandate has been very different from previous mandates in the past decades. A global, deadly pandemic and the return of war to European soil have affected significantly the parliamentary work, agendas and the parliamentary diplomacy activities of the Committee on Foreign Affairs. AFET's annual reports on EU's common foreign and security policy (CFSP) continued to highlight the need for stronger, more ambitious and credible EU action on the world stage, in the face of the threat posed to the rules-based international order and peace by autocratic regimes and their alliances.

The Russian war of aggression against Ukraine and the instability in areas that are geographically close to the EU such as the Sahel, the Middle East or the Caucasus have brought foreign affairs and geopolitics to the forefront, together with a marked interest on security and defence matters.

Ukraine and the war have been regularly present in the activities of AFET since 24 February 2022. On that very day, the Committee on Foreign Affairs held an extraordinary meeting condemning Russia's aggression in the strongest terms. Since then, Ukraine became a standing agenda point of AFET committee meetings, covering a wide range of issues such as the ongoing war and the EU support to Ukraine, EU sanctions on Russia, the reconstruction of Ukraine, granting candidate status to Ukraine, and more recently the establishment of the Ukraine Facility. Notably, AFET was the leading voice in the EU institutions calling for the use of the profits of Russian frozen assets for the reconstruction of Ukraine. This demand was included in EU legislation. Furthermore, AFET has travelled to Ukraine twice during the 9th legislature.

AFET has repeatedly demonstrated its responsiveness to major globally disruptive events by meeting quickly after dramatic events, sometimes on the same day (e.g.



on the day Russia started its war of aggression against Ukraine) or within 48 hours (e.g. following the withdrawal of coalition forces from Afghanistan in August 2021 or after Hamas' terrorist attacks against Israel in October 2023). AFET has also assessed the humanitarian consequences of Israel's military response in Gaza/West Bank, and the use of EU humanitarian aid.

The enlargement policy represents a significant part of AFET's responsibility, both in terms of reports and committee agenda points. During the 9th legislature, the enlargement process has continued in the Western Balkans and has been extended to Ukraine, Moldova and Georgia. AFET, as leading committee for enlargement, has provided political directions to the European Commission. AFET paid visits to Ukraine, Moldova, Georgia, the Western Balkans and Türkiye.

The redefinition of the EU-UK relation was also an important topic on the AFET agenda. AFET led together with the Committee on International Trade (INTA) in the consent procedure for the EU-UK Trade and Cooperation Agreement, the legislative proposal related to its implementation and enforcement, and adoption of the first implementation report, as well as paying a visit to the United Kingdom. AFET and INTA were also jointly responsible for modernising EU-Chile relations, scrutinising and approving the Advanced Framework Agreement. AFET also scrutinised the progress made in the negotiations on EU's agreements with Mercosur, Mexico, Switzerland, Andorra and San Marino, just to name a few. Scrutiny of the implementation of the external financial instruments (in particular NDICI, ENI and IPA) and existing partnership and association agreements (in particular Ukraine, Moldova and Georgia) also remained an important focus.

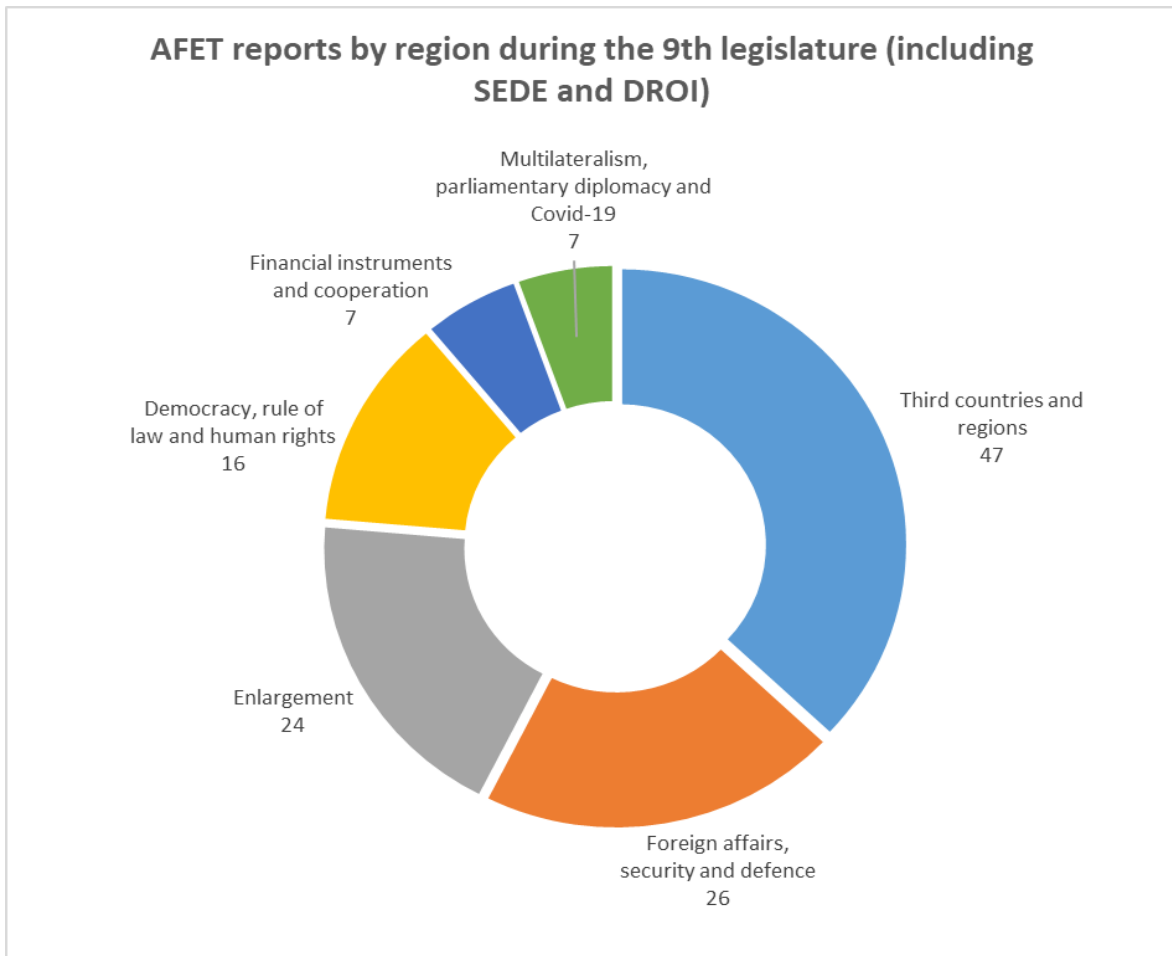
Responding to a rapidly changing geopolitical context, parliamentary diplomacy and direct engagement with the third countries was an important component of activities. AFET travelled to six African countries as well as to partners around the world in the Caucasus, Central Asia, the Arctic, the Gulf, South-East Asia, and Latin America, the latter within the context of the negotiations of the agreements with Chili, Mexico and with the Mercosur. Furthermore, on top of visiting the US and the UN Headquarters, AFET travelled to Japan and paid its first ever visit to Taiwan.

## KEY FIGURES

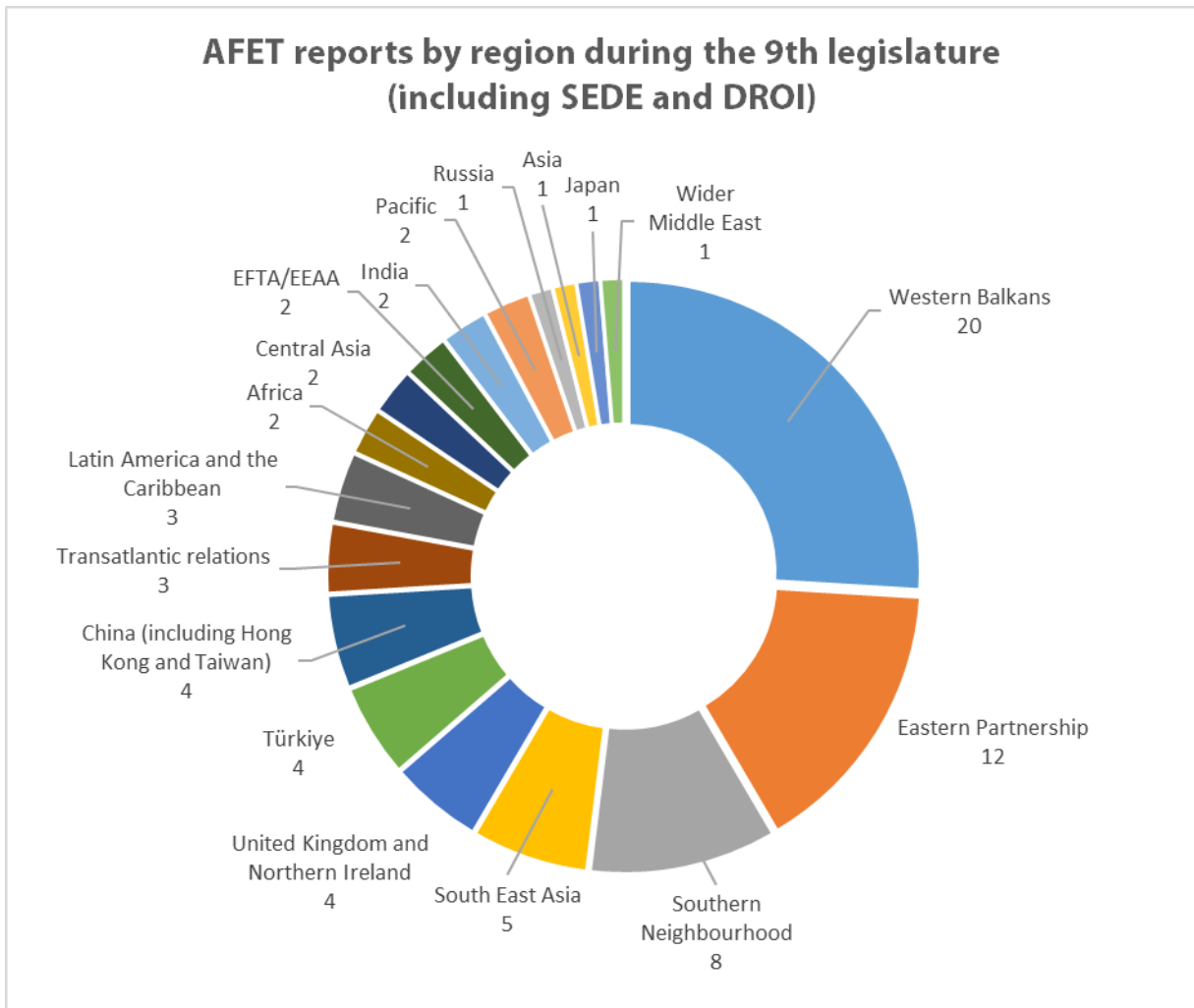
During the 9th term, AFET, with its two Subcommittees on Human Rights (DROI) and Security and Defence (SEDE) adopted 127 reports (Annex 1) covering EU foreign, security and defence policy, foreign relations and international agreements with third countries, external financial instruments, the state of democracy, rule of law and human rights. These points were also raised during 34 public hearings (Annex 2), 36 missions abroad (Annex 3), 314 exchanges of views with high-level guests (Annex 4) and 27 pieces of external expertise.

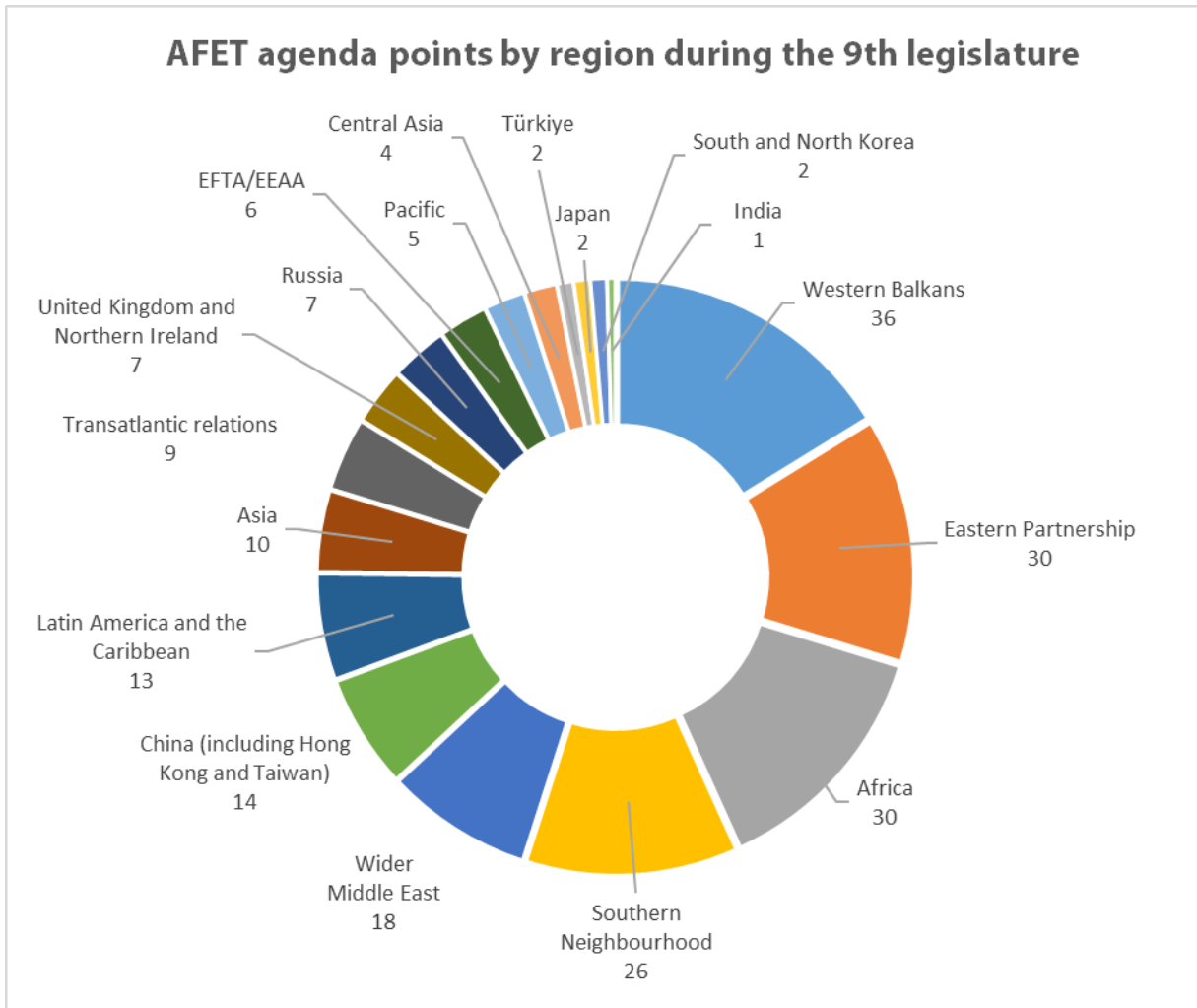
**Figure 1: THEMATIC BREAKDOWN OF AFET REPORTS DURING THE 9th LEGISLATURE**

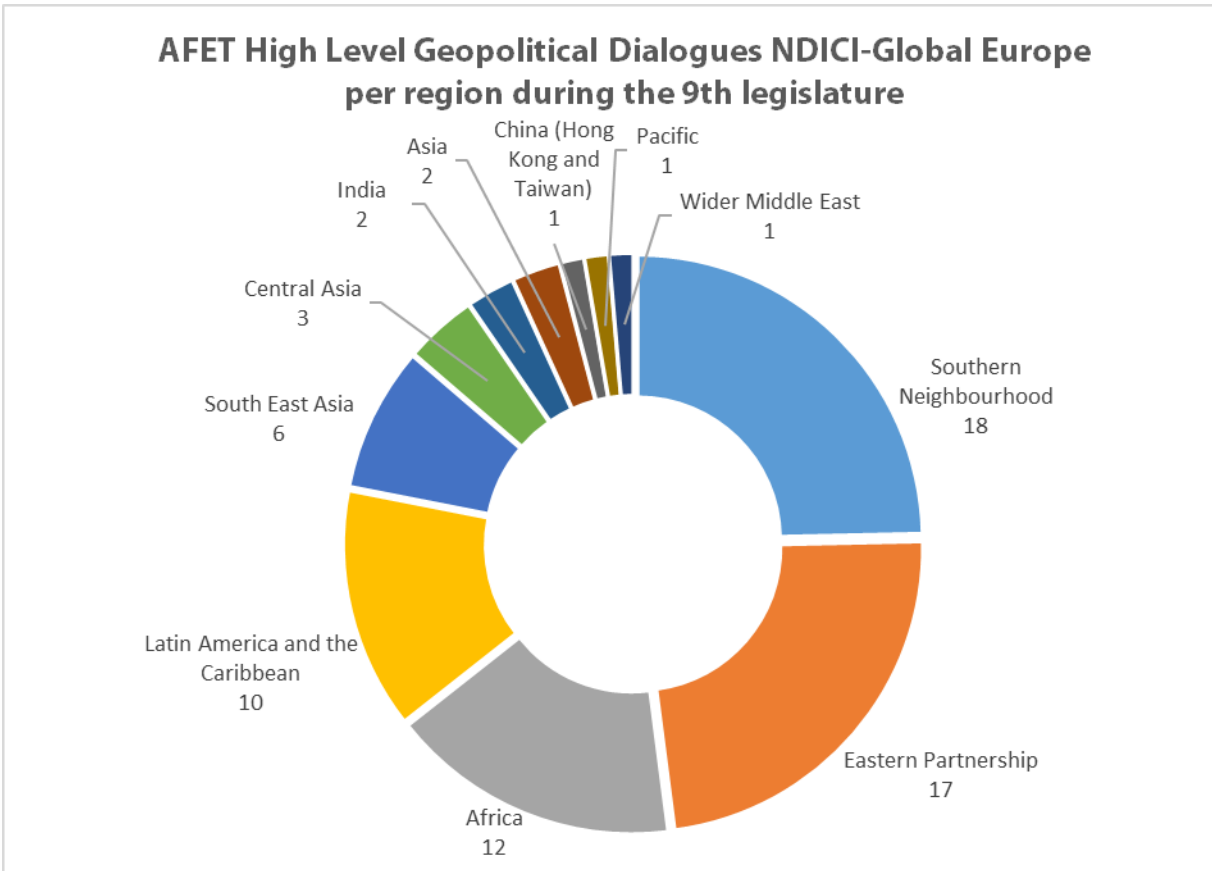


**Figure 3: GEOGRAPHIC BREAKDOWN OF AFET AGENDA POINTS DURING THE 9th LEGISLATURE**

Figures 1 and 2 provide the thematic and geographic coverage of the AFET reports. Figure 3 provides a geographic breakdown of AFET's agenda points.

**Figure 2: GEOGRAPHIC BREAKDOWN OF AFET REPORTS DURING THE 9th LEGISLATURE**

During the 2019-2024 mandate, the AFET Committee developed substantially its scrutiny activities in the area of External and Pre-accession Financial Instruments through the High-Level Geopolitical Dialogues. The Ukraine Facility and the Western Balkans Facility officialised the High-Level Geopolitical Dialogues, making them part of EU law.
