I.2.1. Extraordinary CCC meeting 29 January 2025

The Chair shortly informed the Coordinators on the CCC meeting of 29 January with the Commission Vice-Presidents ahead of the adoption of the Commission Work Programme.

I.2.2. Participation of interest representatives in events (public hearings, exchange of views, workshops,...) held on Parliament's premises

The Chair reminded to the Coordinators the rules governing the participation of interest representatives in all events held on Parliament's premises and rules governing public hearings.

She also asked them to respect IMCO practice not to go beyond the invitation of the institutional stakeholders (e.g. Commission, Committee of Region/EESC) and BusinessEurope and BEUC, when holding an EoV on a file with a Rapporteur that did not receive the attention of the Coordinators for a public hearing.

I.2.3. Modalities of cooperation with other Committees – State of Play

The Chair shortly summarised the state of play of the modalities of cooperation on the open files and exchanged with Coordinators on the possible way forward.

Coordinators agreed to:

- request an opinion to JURI INL *'The 28th Regime: a new legal framework for innovative companies'* and an opinion to EMPL INL *'Digitalisation, AI and algorithmic management in the workplace'*;
- not to request an opinion to JURI INI *'Copyright and Generative AI: opportunities and challenges'* and to ECON INI *'The impact of artificial intelligence on the financial sector'*.
