




### To Walk the Earth in Safety

#### In 2021:


- US supported CWD efforts in 63 countries
- Provided more than \$265 million in funding
- Worked with 52 implementing partners

The implementing partners and programs

- Released more than 141 million square meters of land for safe and productive use
- Destroyed more than 250,000 pieces of SA ammunition & 2,499 metric tons of munitions
