Democracy and Anti-Corruption Strategy: The Role of Civil Society in Preventing and Combating Corruption in Indonesia*

Abstract

ABSTRACT Corruption is an impediment to development and also amounts to a violation of human rights. 1 The fight against corruption is a requirement in the good governance program. 2 Civil society as the biggest stakeholder in a State has the prominent role in the fight against corruption. 3 Indonesia placed at 107th rank in the Corruption Perception Index (CPI) and is one among states which are severely impeded by corruption. 4 Corruption in Indonesia is rampant and pervasive, several cases such as Cicak versus Buaya case and the appointment of Budi Gunawan have attracted public attention massively. 5 Indonesian civil society gunawan has actively engaged in the processes of these cases and their voice did make change, for example in the case of Cicak versus Buaya, the voice of civil society has led to the deponering decision of Bibit and Chandera's prosecution. 6 This article aims to explain the legal framework on the participation of civil society with regard to corruption prevention and to conceptualize the role of the civil society in combating corruption by taking the evidence of emerging civil society and its relation to anti-corruption in Indonesia. This article also aims to explain the relationship between civil society, democracy and good governance as a strategic anti-corruption measures.

Abstract

Abstract

Antioxidant-containing cosmetic has antiaging therapy that can inhibit the free radical formation. Mangosteen peel extract has very strong antioxidant activity. To enhance the effect and comfortness of mangosteen peel extract use on the skin, it could be made into nanoemulgel. The article provides the information about method of preparation and evaluation of nanoemulsion-gel. The purpose of this study was to formulate a stable microemulgel of mangosteen peel extract using halal materials declared halal according to Islamic Shari'a. the materials used don't contain carrion, blood, pig and/ animals that don't conform to Islamic Shari'a. Microemulgel mangosteen peel extract was made by varying plantacare® 1200 UP concentration as cosurfactant (5, 10, 15, 20 and 25%) in the microemulsion and it was incorporated into the gel base. Evaluations were included the antioxidant activity test and organoleptic, pH, viscosity, stability, particle size analysis and panelist test. The antioxidant activity determined by DPPH method showed that IC50 value of mangosteen peel extract was 5.54 ppm. The third microemulsion formula containing cosurfactant of 15% resulted in the best results in that the parameter of the product can be penetrated by ray laser was at particle size of 23.65 nm, was determined by transmission Electron Microscopy (TEM). Microemulgel containing Viscolam® MAC 10 of seven percent gave the stable formula proofed by freeze thaw and sentrifuga test. The five microemulgel formulations were stable.

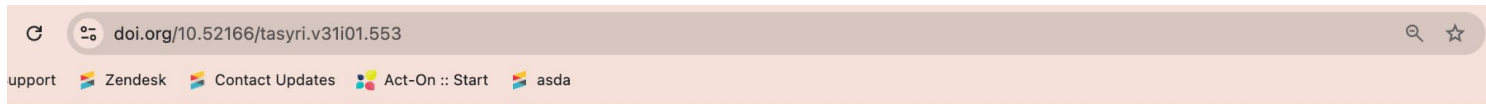

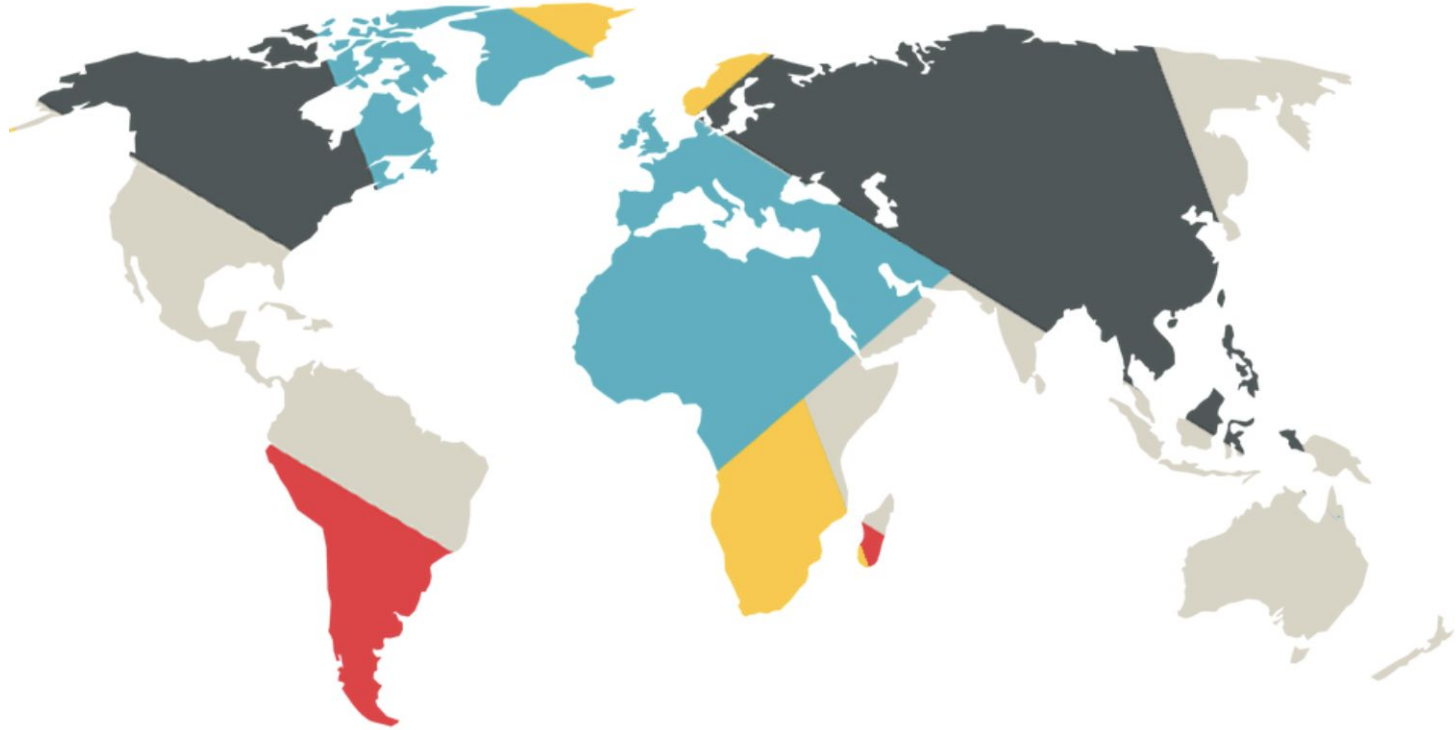

The DOI

- Each DOI works as both a *locator* for that published item and a *container* for a record of metadata about that item.
- They are made up of prefixes and suffixes, each with their own meaning.
- Clicking on a DOI that is formatted as a URL will take you to the location of the item stored in that DOI's metadata record.

Metadata

What is metadata?

Metadata is data that provides information about other data but not the content of the data itself.

What kind of <Metadata>?

Basic: titles; dates; author names; abstracts; DOI; location URL

Full-text URLs: e.g. for text-mining and Similarity Check

Crossmark: updates, retractions, corrections

Relationships: versions; translations; data; references; citation

Provenance: publisher/funder/steward information

Subject-specific: e.g. clinical trial info

Funding information: Funder Registry ID; award numbers/Grant DOIs

Contributor & Affiliations: ORCID iDs and ROR IDs preferred

What does metadata do?

Research integrity

Metadata as signals of trustworthiness including provenance information

Reproducibility

Metadata as relationships between literature, data, software, protocols and more

+

Assessment

Metadata can be used to analyze the outcomes of research and demonstrate compliance

Discoverability

More metadata means more systems have more pathways to find your work

Metadata should be:

Compatible: for use by machines and people

Complete: include as much data as possible

Credible: error-free

Maintained: make updates, add new data

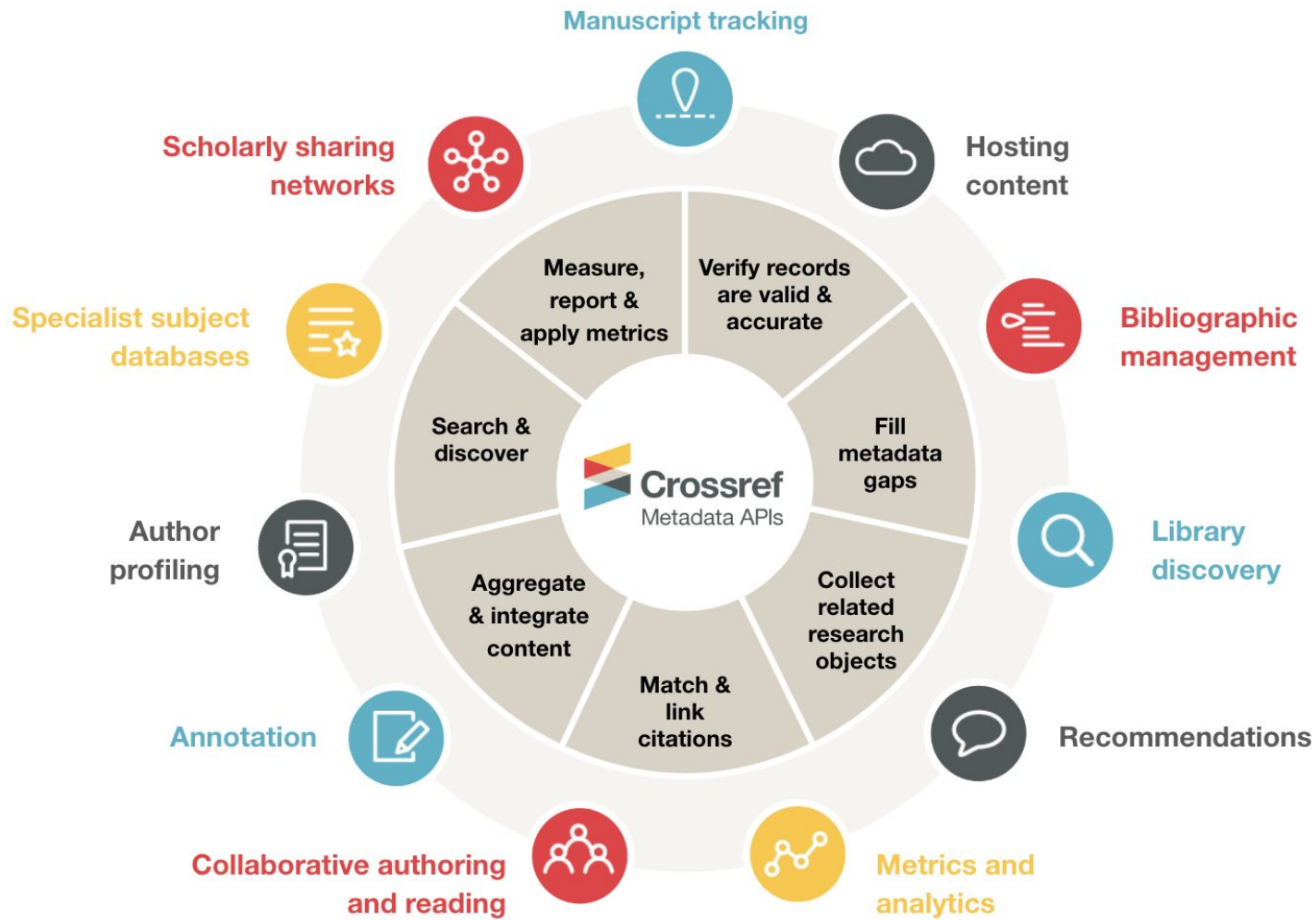
Getting your metadata right

- **Clean:** identify and correct any errors.
- **Complete:** add more when available (references, ORCID iDs, funding data, licence information}
- **Up-to-date:** metadata may change over time, such as when a URL is updated, so make sure your metadata is updated with these changes.

But what if it is wrong?

Common errors

- Missing or incorrectly spelled author names
- Out-of-date metadata
 - URL changes that mean the DOI no longer works
 - Missing publication dates
 - Updates made in OJS but not sent to Crossref
- Incorrect ORCIDs
- Titles that don't match
- Spelling mistakes
