You can view available plugins from the Dashboard by clicking **Website** under the **Settings** header on the left sidebar.


Then, on the main screen of the Dashboard, click the **Plugins** tab.

### DOI Suffix

A DOI suffix can take any form, but must be unique among all publishing objects with the same DOI prefix assigned:

- Use default patterns.

%j.v%vi%i for issues

%j.v%vi%i.%a for articles

%j.v%vi%i.%a.g%g for galleys.

- Enter an individual DOI suffix for each published item. You'll find an additional DOI input field on each item's meta-data page.

- Use the pattern entered below to generate DOI suffixes. Use %j for journal initials, %v for the volume number, %i for the issue number, %Y for the year, %a for the OJS article ID, %g for the OJS galley ID, %f for the OJS file ID, %p for the page number and %x for "Custom Identifier".


These are the final two options. They should be treated with caution.

- **Reassign DOIs** will unassign all DOIs for your journal and reassign DOIs based on whatever your prefix settings are. If you've registered anything, **do not click this**.
- **Assign DOIs** will assign a DOI to anything in your journal that does not already have one.

# DOIs in OJS 3.3 (LTS)

DOIs **are not** automatically assigned. In the **Publication tab** for any submission, you can click on "Identifiers" in the sidebar and see DOI information.

You'll see an **"assign"** button to automatically generate a DOI based on your prefix settings.



# Why integrate ORCID?

- Allow researchers to collect their published work in one place
- Allows researchers to distinguish themselves and claim credit for their work no matter how many people have the same (or similar) name
- Demonstrate commitment to transparency and credibility by accurately attributing authors to their works

## Public API

Allows any journal to pull public metadata from ORCID. In OJS, the public API option

Facilitates:

- Authors can connect their ORCID ID with their publications.
- ORCID IDs recorded as metadata will be deposited in DOI registrations with Crossref and Datacite.
- Author ORCID IDs will be linked on article landing pages.

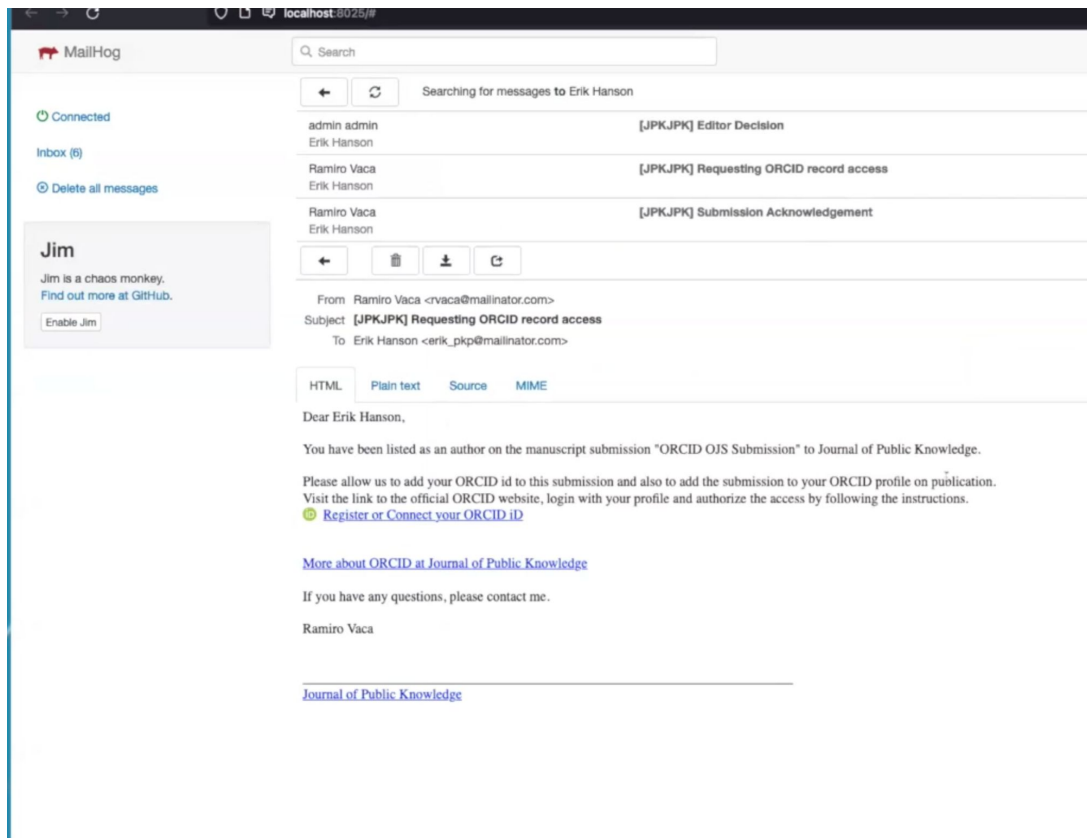
## Private API

Allows journals to push metadata to ORCID. The member API allows for all of the capability of the public, and also:

- Peer-review activity can be pushed to author's ORCID profile.
- Article records can be pushed directly to ORCID profiles.
